- 1.) All major tree removals/trimmings must receive prior approval by the ARB (Architectural Review Board). Work can be halted if the appropriate approval has not been obtained.
- 2.) Grass clippings, brush, tree limbs and any other debris will not be dumped on vacant lots.
- 3.) Leaves, grass clippings and all other debris will not be blown into any streets, ponds, vacant lots or neighboring lots.
- 4.) All areas involved must be left in a neat and orderly manner.
- 5.) Sprinkler heads that direct water onto any street or golf course sign must be corrected.
- 6.) Gate passes must be visibly displayed at all times.
- 7.) No work may commence before 7:00 AM.
- 8.) POA streets and roads shall not be used for overnight staging or storing of contractor landscaping equipment or materials.
- 9.) Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in a contractor not being allowed to perform landscape work in Pawleys Plantation.
